Google Keep

- Free
- Simple to use – think Sticky Notes
- No Printing – have to export to Google Docs
- Find – but no replace
- Web only – no desktop app
- Can't mark images or PDFs
- Poor web clipper

Microsoft OneNote

- Free
- Syncs – with OneDrive
- Handwriting Recognition
- Spell Check
- Search and Replace
- Print Notes
- Export to most formats
- Has Web Clipper

- Limited Free Version

- Free Open Source
- Designed As Evernote Replacement

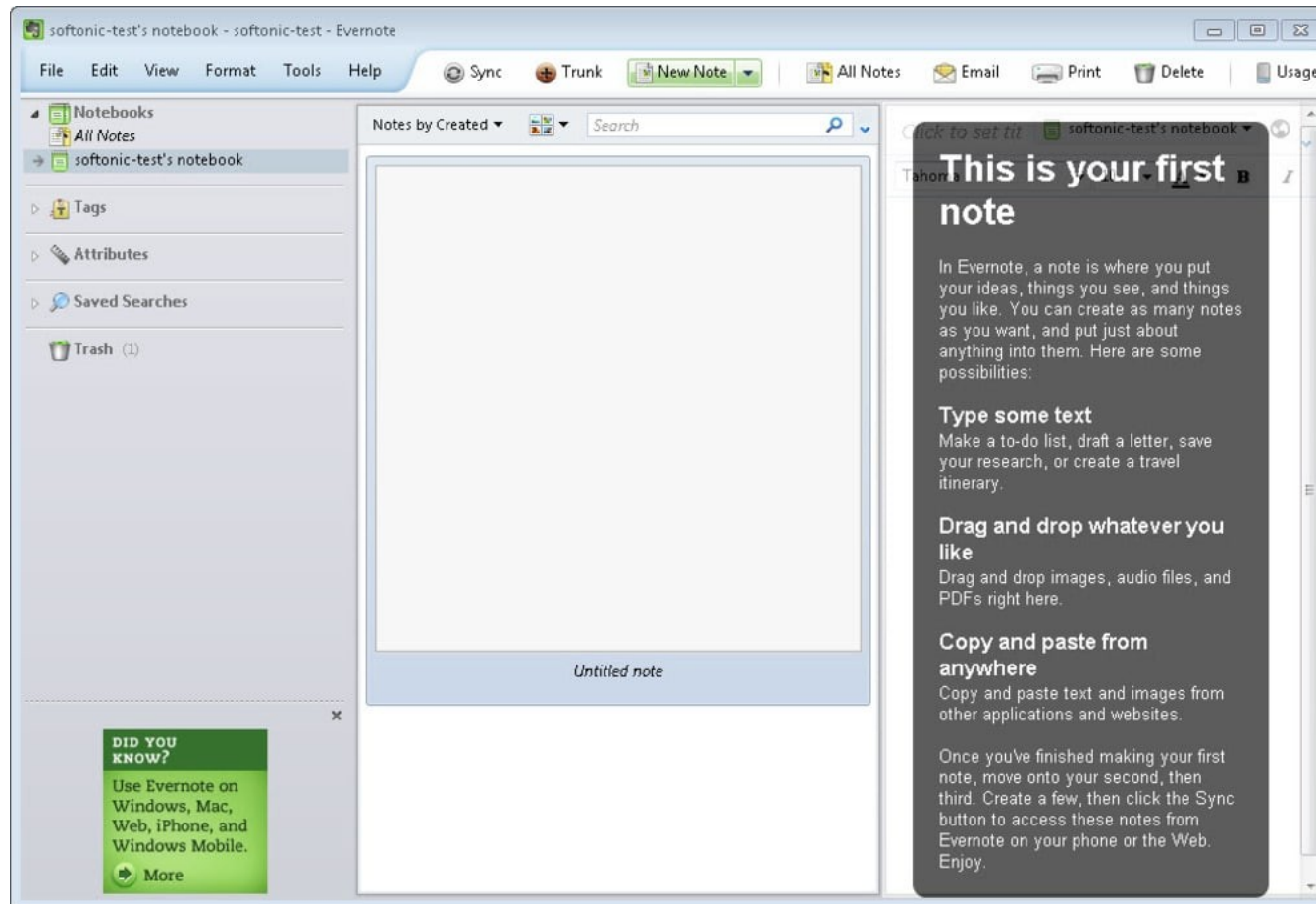
