



Lets try to make downloading easier to do.


A download manager is a software tool that manages the downloading of files from the Internet It may be built into a Web browser. Stand-alone managers are usually more sophisticated with more features.

Built In Browser Managers

- Available in all modern browsers
- Usually activate automatically when clicking the download link
- Most will activate by right-clicking the object and selecting "download" or "save as"


Sometimes the browser can use some assistance

Download Managers Assist Browsers



A download manager is a program that makes downloading files faster, easier and more reliable. Most people don't need a download manager, but under the right circumstances such software can be very useful.

If you routinely download many files, a download manager could save you significant amounts of time. If you have slow or unreliable Internet service, a download manager will make the best use of your scarce resources.



Download Manager Features

- All programs don't have every feature:
 - 1) Prioritize downloads
- 2) Resume failed downloads
- 3) Accelerate download speed
- 4) Schedule download time
- 5) Batch downloading
- 6) Organized download folders
- 7) And more

How Can Files Download Faster?

Several things the manager might or might not do:

- Download from a faster mirror site
- Download the file in sections (similar to Torrent)
- Adjust your computer settings
- 1) Change Task Manager priority

2) Use more RAM

- Create additional Internet connections
- Lie about their speed

Browser Extensions

- 1) Are almost always browser specific
- 2) It is best to do an extension search for your specific need. Example "image downloader"
- 3) I've found that most are not extremely reliable

Stand-Alone Download Managers

- Not as popular as in the past. Fast Internet speed killed the need.
- Paid versions usually have more features. They often have free trial periods or programs.
- Like everything, I recommend you research and read user reviews.
- The best way to see if a Download Manager fits your needs is to download and try.

Free Downloaders to Try

Xtreme Download Manager

- Refresh link feature to resume download from expired links
- Frequent updates with good support
- Browser integration
- Supports multiple download queues
- Open source & works on all platforms

Ninja Download Manager

- Multiple queues management
- Refresh links support
- Sites manager
- Log viewer
- Clipboard monitoring

Free Download Manager

- BitTorrent support
- Download tags management
- Speed limiter with different traffic modes
- Download scheduler
- Cannot refresh expired links

Internet Download Accelerator

- Advanced download scheduler
- FTP explorer
- Customizable interface
- Multiple mirror download
- History & Recycle bin
- Has ads on the interface

Final Thoughts

- Most people really don't need to use a Download Manager
- Stand alone Download Managers are usually more reliable than Browser Extensions
- I didn't talk about paid programs. The free ones are more than adequate.
