Microsoft Edge Browser



Microsoft Edge is a cross-platform web browser developed by Microsoft.

It was first released for Windows 10 and Xbox One in 2015, then for Android and iOS in 2017, and for macOS in 2019. It was released for Linux in 2020.

EdgeHTML was the proprietary layout engine originally developed for Edge. It was a fork of Trident which removed all legacy code of older versions of Internet Explorer. The majority of its source code was rewritten to support web standards and interoperability with other modern browsers.

This project was abandoned and it is now known as Microsoft Legacy Edge.

The new Microsoft Edge is based on the Chromium open-source project. Chromium forms the basis of Google Chrome, so the new Edge feels very similar to Google Chrome. It includes features found in Chrome, supports Chrome browser extensions and has the same rendering engine as Google Chrome.
