Mozilla Firefox or simply Firefox, is a free and open-source web browser developed by the Mozilla Foundation and its subsidiary, the Mozilla Corporation.

Open source means anyone can download and edit the source code (with limitations).

Firefox uses the Gecko layout engine to render web pages.

Firefox is officially available for Windows 7 or newer, macOS, and Linux. Unofficial ports are available for various Unix and Unix-like operating systems including FreeBSD, OpenBSD, NetBSD, illumos and Solaris Unix. It is also available for Android and iOS.

How Does Firefox Make Money?

- Mozilla is a California non-profit corporation
- Revenues come from both corporate and private donations
- Other revenues come from licensing agreements
- Google provides more than 80% of Firefox's income
