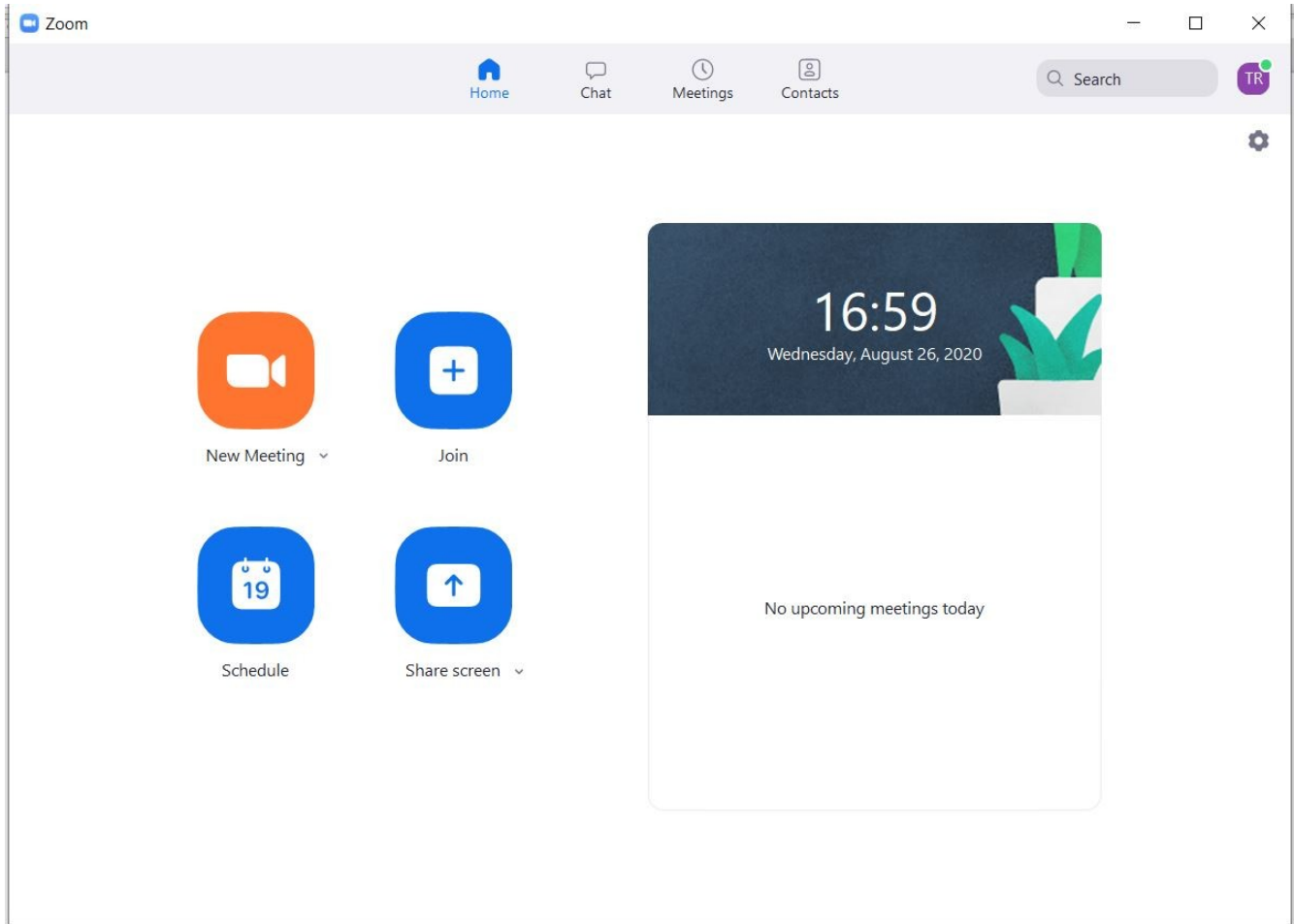
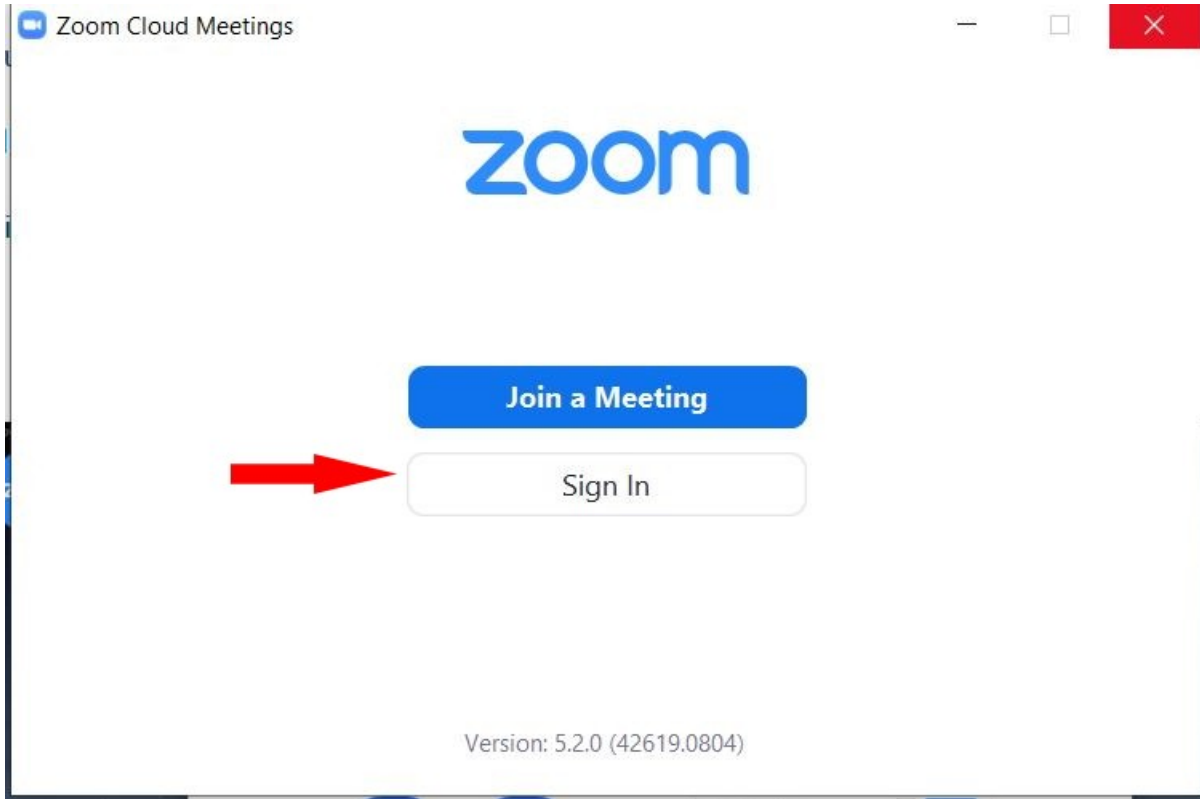


How to Update Your Zoom Client




1. Open your Zoom program
2. Select the **Sign In** option



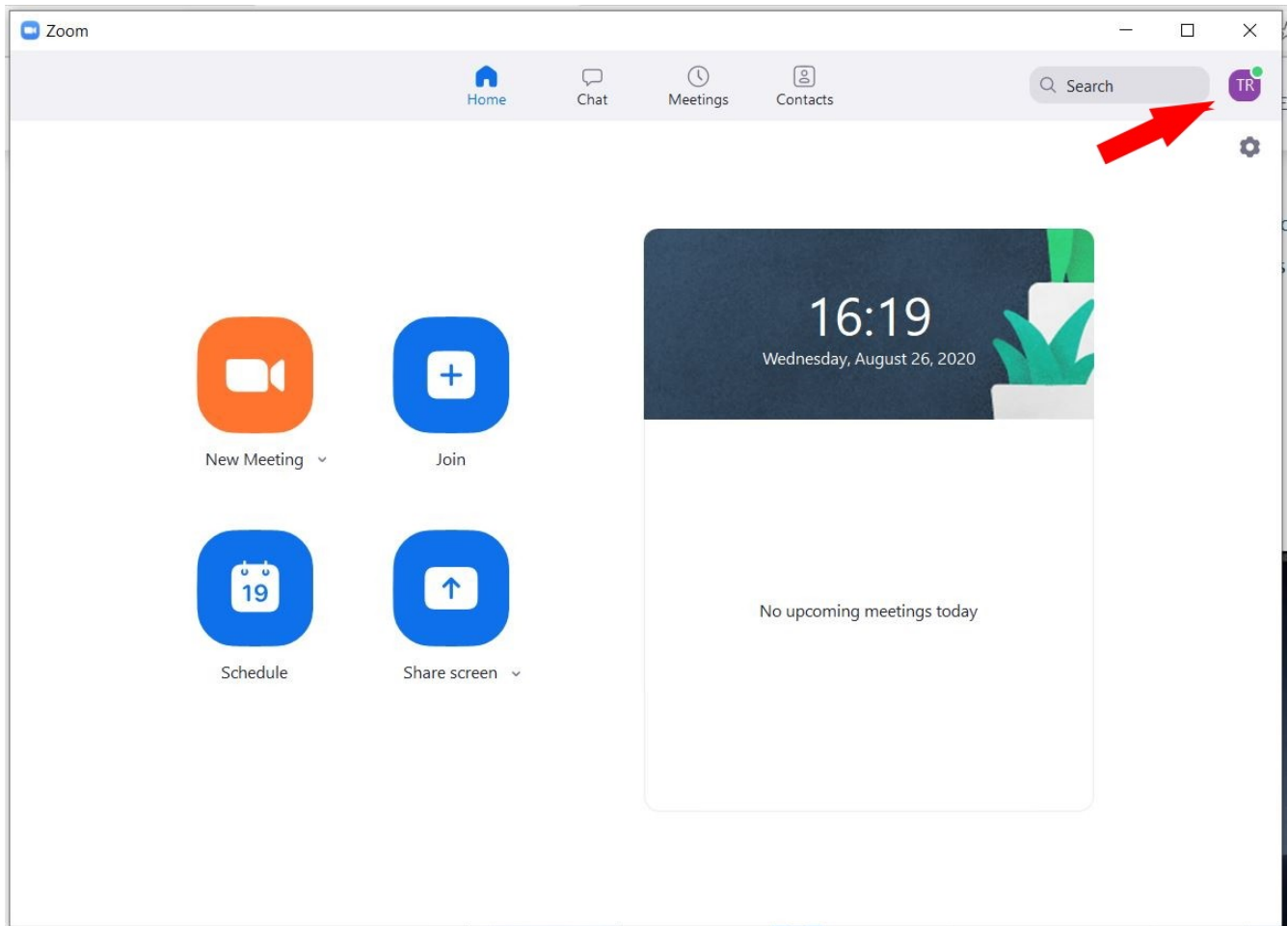
3. If you have a Zoom account, sign in with your e-mail and password. You can also sign in with your Google or Facebook account.

4. If you prefer not to sign in, close the program and go to step 7.

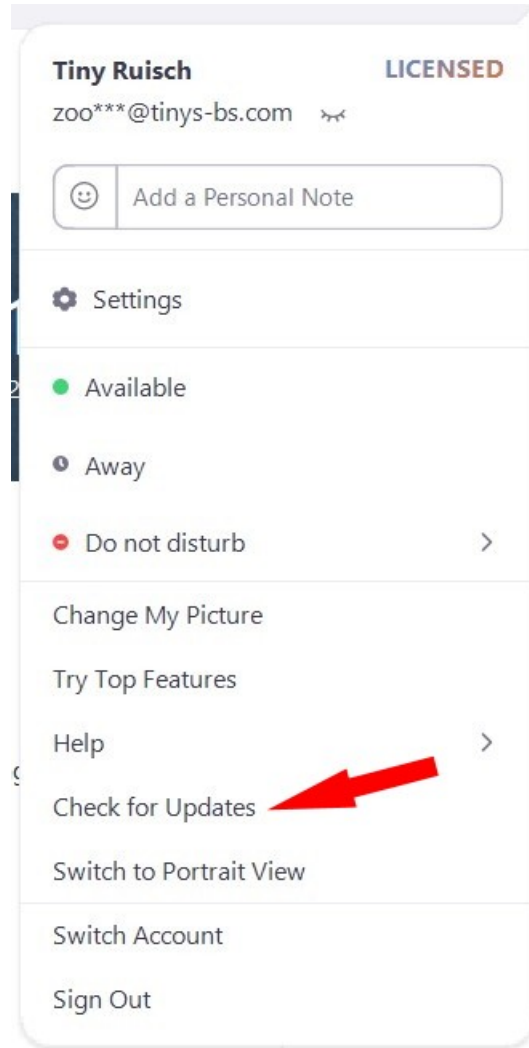
